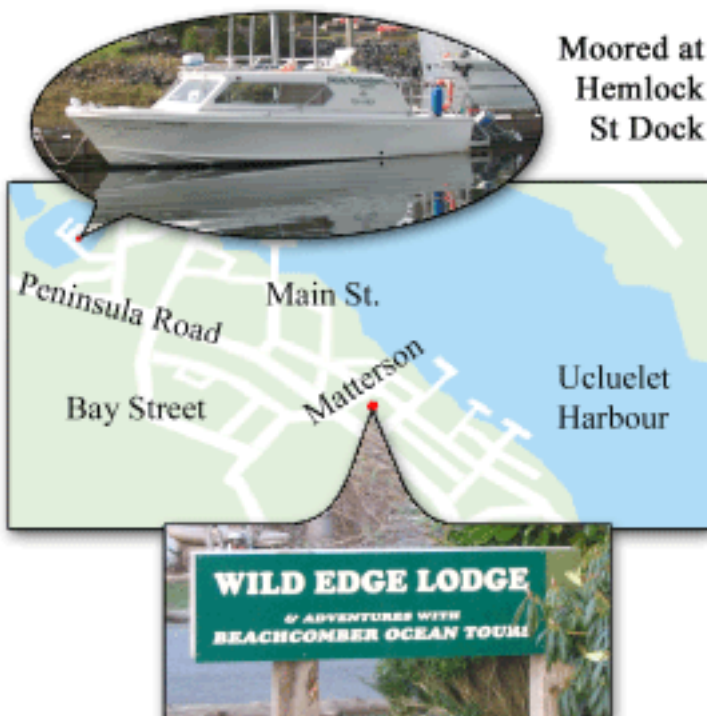


Driving to Wild Edge Lodge or Beachcomber Ocean Tours

If you are driving to Vancouver Island, you will need to take a ferry. From Vancouver or Powell River you can travel via [B.C. Ferries](#) to Nanaimo, Victoria, or Comox. From Port Angeles, Washington you can travel via the [Coho Ferry](#) to Victoria. From Anacortes, Washington you can take a ferry via [Washington State Ferries](#) to Sidney, near Victoria.

Once you arrive on Vancouver Island, the Island Highway runs the entire length of Vancouver Island from Victoria to Port Hardy along the east coast. The west coast route is Highway 4.

From Victoria proceed north along Highway 1 and then Highway 19 past Nanaimo. Continue north. Take the exit for Highway 4 to Port Alberni and follow the signs to Ucluelet/Tofino. At the Ucluelet-Tofino junction take a left to Ucluelet.

The highway becomes Peninsula Road as you drive into Ucluelet. Continue past the Co-Op grocery store and turn left on to the second street, Matterson Drive. Wild Edge Lodge is the third on the right.

The road to the west coast are winding and steep as you drive through the mountains. Please check the [weather](#) and [road](#) conditions before you leave. Alternatively you may take the [Tofino Bus](#) to Ucluelet or Tofino from Victoria and Nanaimo. Flights are also available to the Long Beach airport.
